This event happened in the City of Łomża¹ on nineteenth of April, first of May, eighteen eighty-three at seven o'clock in the evening. It is declared that on this day in the presence of witnesses: sexton Moszk Szejnkop, seventy-three years of age and Abraham² Berkowicz, teacher's assistant by occupation and forty years of age, living in the City of Łomża, a holy matrimony is finalized between a nineteen-year-old bachelor Abraham Lejb/Neustein/Baszkiewicz, the son of Szolim and his legally-wedded wife Golda Baszkiewicz (maiden name Krymkiewicz) who resides with his parents in Nowodgod; and twenty-one year old maiden Fajga Wierzba, daughter of legally-wedded spouses Fajba and Chana Wierzba living in the village of Gac, Gmina Puchały, Łomżynski District. Preceding this matrimonial, the union was solemnized thrice by publication in the Nowogrod Synogogue on the second day, the ninth, and the sixteenth of April. The newlyweds declare that they did not form a nuptial union prior to this one; however, they declared their intent to marry to their parents prior to this holy matrimonial which is concluded by Rabbi Lejzor Rabinowicz of Łomża. The event was witnessed and confirmed by reading of this declaration by Rabbi Lejzor Rabinowicz and ourselves, the below signatories, which excludes those who are illiterate.

¹ Lomza is pronounced "Losh'ja" in Russian. This city is located in North East of Poland, approximately 8 miles from Nowogrod.

² The name sounds "Abram" in Russian, but translates to Abraham.
