


**The Marron or Morron Family:
Byerazino to Glasgow**

My information is very limited. When I started my research there were only two living relatives, an aunt & uncle both in their 90s who knew the name Beresina (as they called it) as the place where their parents lived before coming to Glasgow in 1910.

I have read my grandfather's naturalisation file at the National Archives in London & found a bit of information there. Hyman (or Chaim) Marron was born on 15/6/1887. His father was Sholem Wolf Marron who died in 1889. The mother was Chave. Hyman was an only child as far as we know. The name changed from Marron to Morron probably through a communication error.

Hyman was a skilled cabinetmaker & this was his trade both in Belarus & Glasgow. The photo you see here was found amongst my aunt's (his daughter's) possessions and will have been taken before the move to Scotland.

Hyman married Hinde (or Hilda) Rossain (or Rosen) on 25/3/1910. The file refers to the Jewish marriage certificate but it was not on the file. Later that year the couple moved to Glasgow where their 5 children were born. The file mentions Minsk rather than Beresina, but it is Beresina which was always mentioned within the family as the place where they lived.

I don't know whether the Rossains (Rosens) also came from Beresina. Hilda's brother Sam Rosen also lived briefly in Glasgow before immigrating to Australia.
