On the 5th of Oct. we arrived in Erzeminico and called up a meeting of the representatives of the town and got from them the following information:

The total po ulation is 26,000. There are 12,000 Jews in this town, of whom 4,000 are very needy. There 1,500 poor children and 100 orphans. During the war the front line was running at a distance of 3 klms. from Kr eminiec, which suffered very much on account of this. The people are actually destitude. There is no kitchen for feeding the poor. There are 2 Kindergardens for 100 children. A Chachnosis Orchim is practically not working for lack of funds. There is a Jewish hospital with 30 beds and an ambulatory at the hospital. There is an old people's home with 28 inmates. Typhus is raging in the city. There are almost no schools in the city, but the town wants to open some now. Also an orphan asplym is going to be opened out of american funds. The people presented a budget of 110,000 marks a ntiy. Their district consists of the following places:
